AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR PHASE I - 2014 SEWER DIAGNOSTIC WORK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has been determined that certain sanitary sewers are in need of diagnosis of the status of the sewers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications, and assist with the analysis of the diagnostic work for the homeowners for Phase I – 2014 Sewer Diagnostic Work.


SECTION 2. The cost of the engineering work related to the Phase I – Sewer Diagnostic Work will be in an amount not to exceed Forty-Three Thousand Dollars (\$43,000.00), the fees for such work in accordance with the contract with the City Engineer. Funding will be obtained from the Fairview Park Sanitary and Storm Sewer Capital Improvement Fund.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and for the further reason that the inflow and infiltration of water into the sanitary sewage system should be remediated as quickly as possible, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
