AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BLACK AND VEATCH FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE SEWER ISSUES IN THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Black and Veatch has reviewed information relative to the City's sewer system and has made recommendation for addressing flooding issue long term; and

WHEREAS, Black and Veatch has proposed to prepare the scope of services and coordinate the collection of information for other work to be performed.

WHEREAS, Black and Veatch can also provide necessary professional services to develop a collection system model, detailed GIS data analysis and development of a GIS database, determine performance standards for the collection system, develop analysis to improve the system, and provide an expandable model of other areas of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Black and Veatch in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$126,400.00) for the purpose of preparing the scope and coordinating the collection of information in connection with the sewer flooding issue in the City and developing collection system models and related work, to be paid from Sanitary Sewer Fund (510).


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and to immediately begin the process of evaluating the systems and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR FIELD INVESTIGATION WORK IN CONNECTION WITH COLLECTION OF INFORMATION FOR THE SEWER ISSUES IN THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the long term planning process for the development of a plan to address sewer flooding in the City of Fairview Park requires field investigation work, including but not limited to survey work, GIS data collection, sewer evaluations; and

WHEREAS, the City will obtain quotes for the required work and enter into a contract with a qualified firm, at a cost not to exceed thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to solicit quotes and to enter into an agreement with a firm qualified to perform the required field investigation work, an amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00), to be paid from the Sanitary Sewer Fund (510).

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and to immediately obtain the required services and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.



AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR DATA COLLECTION AND FLOW MONITORING IN CONNECTION WITH SEWER EVALUATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the long term planning process to address sewer flooding in the City of Fairview Park includes obtaining services from a qualified firm for data collection and flow monitoring ; and

WHEREAS, the City will obtain quotes for the required work and enter into a contract with a qualified firm, at a cost not to exceed forty-two thousand dollars (\$42,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to solicit quotes and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder in an amount not to exceed Forty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$42,000.00) for the required data collection and flow monitoring work, to be paid from the Sanitary Sewer Fund (510).

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and to immediately obtain the necessary service and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

REQUESTED BY: THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT
SPONSORED BY: COUNCILWOMAN CLEARY

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER TO ADVANCE TAXES FROM THE PROCEEDS OF TAX LEVIES PURSUANT TO SECTION 321.34 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 321.34 of the Ohio Revised Code of the State of Ohio provides that any money in the County Treasury in the account of the City of Fairview Park, and lawfully applicable to the purpose of the current year may be drawn upon request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County be and is hereby requested to draw his Warrants and he is hereby requested to pay to the Director of Finance of the City of Fairview Park any money in the County Treasury to the account of Fairview Park and lawfully applicable to the purposes of the fiscal year 2015. This request includes advances of special assessments.


SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized to furnish a certified copy of this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to obtain the above mentioned advances in order to provide for proper financing of the City's obligations, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
