

WATERING

Regular, thorough watering is of the utmost importance to the survival of newly planted nursery stock.

Plants with **small root balls** should be watered every 3-5 days *with the nozzle off the hose* totally saturating the root ball. For ease of watering, invest in a watering wand.

Larger root balls should be watered every 5-7 days by placing the hose, *with the nozzle off*, on top of the root ball on a slow trickle. Make 3 moves around ball for 10-15 minutes each move. Continue to water **through November**.

HINT: If in doubt, probe around the root ball 2-4" to determine moisture level.

NOTE: LAWN SPRINKLERS, SOAKER HOSES AND SPRAY NOZZLES ARE INEFFECTIVE METHODS FOR WATERING NEWLY PLANTED TREES, SHRUBS AND EVERGREENS.


In just 3 easy steps, you can beautify your tree lawn and make Fairview Park proud to be a Tree City, U.S.A.!

ADOPT-A-TREE

SUGGESTED TREE LAWN TREES

Crabapple - *Spring Snow* or cultivars thereof

White flowering crabapple, no fruit. Height 20-30'

Hawthorn - *Crusader*

White flowers in spring, yellow to orange foliage, with red berries, in fall, no thorns. Height 20'.

Cherry - *Kwanzan* or *Yoshino*

Fruitless, deep-pink double flowers in spring, orange to brown foliage in fall. Height 25'-35'.

Maackia - *Amurensis*

White flowers in spring, green foliage. Height 20'-30'.

Serviceberry - *Autumn Brilliance* or *Cumulus*

White flowers in spring, fall color. Fruit is small and does not drop. Height 20'-25'.

Lilac - *Ivory Silk*, *Regent*, or *Summer Snow*

Japanese lilac with white flowers in spring. Well suited for street planting, grow quickly. Height 20'-30'.

Dogwood - *Cuyahoga Gray*

Creamy white flowers in spring, small fruit. Height 12'-15'.

Plum - *Thundercloud*

Pink flowers in spring, purple foliage. Height 12'-15'.

Maple - *Trident*, *Tatarian*, *Hedge* or cultivars thereof

Trident - orange and red foliage in fall. Height 20'-30'.

Tatarian - yellow foliage in fall. Height 15'-25'.
