
The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. The topic for the meeting is to award the contract for the 2015 Street Repair Program Phase 2.

Three bids were received and opened on June 3, 2015. The Engineer's estimate for the work was \$400,000. The bids received were reviewed by City Engineer Mackay. The apparent low bidder at the time of the bid opening was Barbicus Construction. After review by Engineer Mackay, a mathematical error was discovered. Barbicus Construction was notified and did not wish to amend and resubmit bid. As a result, Cross Roads Asphalt Recycling Inc. became the low bid at \$426,414.55. Cross Roads Asphalt Recycling Inc.'s bid was within the ten percent of the engineer's estimate allowable by Ohio Revised Code.

Service & Development Director Berner reviewed the Street Program with the Board. Mr. Berner explained how the streets were reviewed and scored for repair. He also explained how the cost estimates were prepared for both the cost of repair and the cost against the City budget.

Councilman Minek made a motion to accept the recommendation of Engineer Mackay to award the contract for the 2015 Street Repair Program Phase 2 to Cross Roads Asphalt Recycling Inc in the amount of \$426,414,55. Finance Director Rocco seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved by the Board of Control.

There being no further business before the Board of Control, Councilman Minek made a motion to adjourn. Service & Development Director Berner seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved by the Board of Control


