AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR CLIFFORD DRIVE FROM WEST 212th STREET TO WEST 220th STREET AND FROM WEST 227th STREET TO WEST 229th STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the storm and sanitary sewers located within the right-of-way of Clifford Drive have exceeded their useful life and are in critical need of removal and replacement; and

WHEREAS, on September 23, 2016, the City of Fairview Park submitted an application to request funds from the District One Public Works Integrating Committee of Cuyahoga County and the Ohio Public Works Commission (“OPWC”) to request financial assistance for essential capital improvements to the Clifford Drive storm and sanitary sewers; and

WHEREAS, City Council, by Ordinance No. 16-36, supported the City’s application to the OPWC to fund the Project; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the Project is \$3,991,400, of which the City is required to provide a ten percent (10% match), equaling \$399,140; and

WHEREAS, the City will receive a minimum of \$699,976 in grant funds, and the remainder of the project will be funded by a 30-year no interest loan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to prepared plans and specifications for the removal and replacement of storm and sanitary sewer; and the removal and replacement of storm manholes, sanitary manholes, catch basins, and storm and sanitary sewer laterals.

SECTION 2. That the City Engineer shall be paid for the services rendered in accordance with the Engineer’s Estimate for the Project in the amount not to exceed \$368,000 to be paid from the Sanitary Sewer Fund (510).

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and for the further reason that the storm and sanitary sewers located within the right-of-way of Clifford Drive are in critical need of replacement; and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


