AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES FOR THE NORTH PARK WATER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has been determined that certain water mains on North Park Drive are in need of replacement requiring the City Engineer to prepare plans and specifications and provide construction administration services for said work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications and provide construction administration services for the replacement of certain water mains on North Park Drive.

SECTION 2. That the City Engineer shall be paid for the services rendered in accordance with his contract with the City in amount not to exceed \$53,430 to be paid from the Water Line Reconditioning Fund (550).

SECTION 3. Funding will be obtained from the City of Cleveland to reimburse the City of Fairview Park for the cost of the preparation of the plans and specifications for the project.


SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.


SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and for the further reason that the work be started as soon as possible to ensure the delivery of potable water; and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
