Good Afternoon –

This is the first email to everyone that attended our flooding meeting at City Hall on Wednesday, August 20th. Please feel free to forward this email on to anyone that might be interested. Since our meeting, we have had City crews inspecting the pipes throughout the city by camera. As an aside, pipes have been repaired on Clifford, and on parts of West 220. The results of this work were sent to our Engineering firm, Black & Veatch, who are writing up a report of actions to be taken. That report will be delivered to the City on Friday, October 10th. At that time, the City will review the findings and begin to create the overall project plan. At the present time, we don't have a target date for delivery of the overall plan, but that can be conveyed in a future email.

Work has begun on the creation of a "flooding" section to the City website. It will be located under the Council section, and will contain various documents for homeowners, including the engineering study once received next week. We are currently in the process of gathering documents to share, and hope to have the page live in the next 2-3 weeks.

I am targeting the next update email for November 14th. At that time, I'd like to talk about what work, if any, can be done over the winter, and look forward to 2015 work to be done, along with rough timelines.
