There are several updates I wanted to pass along regarding the City's continued efforts to prevent flooding. The engineering firm of Black & Veatch has conducted an initial overview of the sewer and sanitary water systems, and provided a list of short and long-term recommendations. The report was delivered on October 31st. Black & Veatch representatives will be at the next Council Committee meeting on November 24, at 7pm in City Hall, to go through the report. This meeting is open to the public and you are invited to attend.
