543.01 REMOVAL OF SNOW, DIRT, MERCHANDISE FROM SIDEWALK.

Every owner, occupant or person in control of any lot or land within the City along the front or side of which any sidewalk is located or upon which is located any sidewalk forming a continuation of a sidewalk upon a public highway and designed for use by the public as such a continuation, shall keep the sidewalk and continuation thereof free from snow, ice, slush, dirt and mud and any other foreign substance. No owner, occupant or person in control shall place any merchandise or other object of any sort upon the sidewalk or continuation thereof, or knowingly permit such merchandise or object to remain thereon. A separate offense shall be deemed to have occurred on each day on which the sidewalk or continuation thereof is permitted to remain in a condition herein forbidden, or on which merchandise or other objects are placed or knowingly permitted to remain on the sidewalk or continuation thereof. No sidewalk or continuation thereof shall be required to be cleaned more often than once in any one day, nor before the hour of 9:00 a.m. next following the fall of any snow.

543.02 DEPOSIT OF SNOW.

No person removing snow from any driveway or sidewalk within the City shall deposit the same on the pavement or sidewalk of any public street or on any tree lawn in any public street, except the tree lawn immediately in front on the premises from which the snow is removed. (Ord. 74-36. Passed 5-6-74.)

543.03 STORAGE OF MATERIAL IN STREETS.

No person shall cause to be piled, stored or left on any portion of any public highway any building material or other material or equipment of any kind, nor, being the owner or occupant of any property fronting upon a public highway, permit the placing or storing of any such material on a highway in front of the property. (Ord. 74-36. Passed 5-6-74.)

543.04 DEPOSIT OF LEAVES IN STREETS.

No person shall deposit any leaves within any public street, except on the tree lawn between the sidewalk and the curb. (Ord. 74-36. Passed 5-6-74.)

543.05 PROTECTING SIDEWALKS.

In the transportation of any goods, materials or equipment across any sidewalk in the City, efficient temporary planking shall be used to protect such sidewalks from breakage. Such temporary planking shall be removed at the close of each working day and the surface of the sidewalk immediately cleaned and left in a passable condition. (Ord. 74-36. Passed 5-6-74.)

543.06 LANTERNS AND BARRICADES REQUIRED.

No contractor or other person shall leave unprotected, unguarded or without proper lighting any hole, excavation, pile of dirt, truck, equipment or other material in any of the streets of the City. (Ord. 74-36. Passed 5-6-74.)

543.07 OBSTRUCTIONS ON TREE LAWNS OR DRIVEWAYS.

No person shall place chains, wires, ropes, rocks or other obstructions as a fence or guard across any driveway or on the tree lawn between the property line and curb, on any street. (Ord. 74-36. Passed 5-6-74.)

543.08 COMMERCIAL SNOW REMOVAL; LICENSE AND FEE.

(a) No person, firm or corporation, using a licensed vehicle for removal, collecting or hauling of snow from property within the City, shall do so without first obtaining a "snow removal license" from the City to perform or do such work.

(b) Application for a license shall be upon a form issued by the Director of Public Service and Development and a license shall be granted if the applicant is qualified to perform the work for which the application is sought, is aware of the ordinances governing snow removal, registers the year, make and model of the vehicle or vehicles used for such snow removal and shows evidence of liability insurance, as required by State law.

(c) Evidence of repeated violation of snow removal ordinances or other City ordinances shall be sufficient evidence to disqualify the applicant from receiving a license or for revoking a license. A license for any snow removal work shall be issued to the applicant by the Director upon completion of the application and of provisions set forth in subsection (b) hereof. The fee for such license shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

(d) Such license shall be issued for a period of one season from October 1 of the year that it is issued, and shall expire on May 1 next following the date of issuance. Such license shall be renewed each year thereafter, for a like period upon completion of application and showing proof of insurance.

(e) The snow removal license shall state the name of the licensee, firm name in case of a partnership or corporation, place of business, expiration date, name and address of insurance company, insurance agent and telephone number and the make, model and license number of the vehicle or vehicles used in snow removal.

(f) No person, firm or corporation licensed under the provisions of this chapter shall allow or permit their or its name to be used in acquiring any permit or doing any work as described herein, or permit anyone in his or its employ to do any work unless they too have been licensed by the City.

(g) Permit shall allow licensee to remove snow from private property any time of the day or night when there exists more than two inches of snow on the ground.

(h) Snow shall not be placed or piled on a sidewalk either directly or indirectly so as to obstruct or limit its use to pedestrians.

(i) Snow shall not be placed or piled on or against any fence or living fence of an adjacent property. Snow shall remain on the property from which it is cleared or hauled out of the City. (Ord. 85-73. Passed 11-18-85.)

543.99 PENALTY.

(a) Whoever violates any provision of this chapter where another penalty is not otherwise provided is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree. (See Section 501.99 for penalties applicable to any misdemeanor classification.)

(b) Whoever violates Section 543.01 or 543.02 is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. (Ord. 81-76. Passed 6-29-81.)
