2. Continue to submit our volunteer hours to the City.
3. Most Valuable Tree (MVT) Planning:
 - a. Community Allies: Joe at Chestnut Trees, Amy at Messiah Lutheran, Colleen S. at High School, Chris Garrett has aerial views of the city of old trees, Sign Guy Kerry has photos of Westgate Mall area of old trees, Matt Hruby, Fairview Park Historical Society, Cleveland Tree photos at the library, Garden Club and Community Garden.
 - b. Tree Nominations: need locations. Mary Alice has map of city with identified trees marked.
 - c. Announcing MVT: First the Mayor and Council. Mary Alice will send an email to Bridget Hinkel that a big project is coming and can we meet with the Mayor to review project.
 - d. Touring: Senior Bus for tree tours. Mike will run it by Shawn and Bill regarding insurance. Discussion how this will operate on Day of Unveiling.
 - e. Signage: Goal is to show the city the beauty/value of trees. Steve has audio technical designer to help with signs "Ask me about MVT". We may place signs a week before and after Summerfest, or perhaps all summer/fall. Want Facebook entries each week April-July. 4. Summerfest: Raffles \$1/Ticket and pulled every 2.5 hours. Will raffle small trees/garden tools, tree guards. Need donations. Need volunteers to sign up, Penn sent list. Saturday is the busiest day, Sunday morning is busy. Will purchase canopy with a wall for \$35 to keep volunteers cool in the hot sun.
5. Arbor Day: We will minimize our role in Arbor Day due to MVT project work load. Joe Riordan will have three (3) Chestnut Trees to plant for Arbor Day.
6. State of the Community: March 14, 2018, 7pm-8:30pm. Mary Alice will email Bridget that we will have a table there. Doreen to go early and set up.
7. Permeable Materials: If this product replaces hard surface, we like it. We still want access to the trees. Need to have organic leaf hummus.
8. Penn attended the Community Council meeting on January 29, 2018. We need to pay. Distributed "Coyotes in the Urban Environment" from OSU Extension.
9. Hillsdale Tree Planting Project: Penn hosted Doreen, May Alice and three (3) other residents. Lots of energy about getting trees, within city code, for both sides of Hillsdale. Perhaps the City "List of Acceptable Trees" will be revised. Hope to plant trees this falls. We will distribute a flyer to neighbors to notify and invite involvement. Next meeting is Saturday, March 10, 2018.
