AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENGAGE CIUNI & PANICHI INC. TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SERVICES AS PART OF THE 2018 FISCAL YEAR AUDIT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Fairview Park is required to have an independent audit of its financial records each year; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 15-52, passed by Council on authorized the Mayor to enter into an extension agreement with Ciuni and Panichi, Inc. to audit the basic financial statements of the City of Fairview Park for Fiscal Years 2015 through 2018; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the independent audit to include an audit modification of the implementation of Government Accounting Standards Board (GASB) Statement No. 75 which was not a part of the initial contracted hours with Ciuni and Panichi, Inc. GASB Statement No. 75, Accounting and Financial Reporting for Postemployment Benefits Other Than Pensions, addresses reporting by governments that provide Ohio Postemployment Benefit Plans Other Than Pension Plans (OPEB) to their employees and for governments that finance OPEB for employees of other governments.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the extension agreement with Ciuni and Panichi, Inc. to include services pertaining to GASB 75.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an amendment of the extension agreement with Ciuni & Panichi, Inc. in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-four Dollars (\$1,274.00), to provide additional services to include an audit of modification of the implementation of GASB 75.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be m emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and to immediately begin the FY 2018 audit process, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law,

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICE (ODAS) COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM WITH VALLEY FORD TRUCK, INC. TO PURCHASE A FORD F-550 TRUCK CAB AND CHASIS AND EQUIPMENT FOR SAID TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Public Service Department currently uses a 2000 Ford F-550 to support day to day operations and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the 2000 Ford F-550 is aging and although no longer able to fully perform all functions serves as a viable watering truck and back-up vehicle for the short term; and

WHEREAS, the Public Service Department is in need of a new Ford F-550 truck with a dump body to support day to day operations and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, a 2019 Ford F-550 4x2 Regular Cab 145 inch wheelbase cab chassis can be purchased from Valley Ford Truck, Inc. utilizing a State of Ohio Contract Number 902619 Index Number GDC093.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Valley Ford Truck, Inc., who offers a new 2019 Ford F-550 4x2 Regular Cab 145 inch wheelbase cab chassis to the City of Fairview Park using State of Ohio Contract 902619 Index Number GDC093.

SECTION 2. That the cost of the purchase of the vehicle shall not exceed thirty-seven thousand two hundred twenty-six dollars (\$37,226) be paid in one lump sum payment from the Sanitary Sewer Fund (Fund 510).

SECTION 3. That the cost of the dump body, snow plow assembly, safety lights, other associated equipment, and labor for installation shall not exceed twenty-two thousand seven hundred thirty dollars (\$22,730) to be paid in one lump sum payment from the Sanitary Sewer Fund (Fund 510) as described in attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and so that the truck can be ordered immediately and available for use by the Service Department, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force from immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF ALL OF THE STREETS OF FAIRVIEW PARK, OHIO PROVIDING AND SUPPLYING SAID STREETS WITH ELECTRIC STREET LIGHTING FOR THE TAX YEARS 2020 AND 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving all of the streets in the City of Fairview Park, Ohio, by providing and supplying said streets with electric lighting for the tax years of 2020 and 2021, in the approximate aggregate amount of \$300,000 for each said tax year, as reported to the Finance Director and now on file in the office of the Finance Director; be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, and that for the tax years 2020 and 2021, these be and are hereby levied and assessed upon the lots, lands and property bounding and abutting on said streets, or parts thereof, and served by said street lighting, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments are in proportion to the tax value thereof, and are not in excess of any statute of limitation; and said lots, lands and property are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement.

SECTION 2. That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid out of the Street Lighting Fund of the City of Fairview Park, Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that the assessments now on file in the office of said Director are in the same proportion to the estimated assessments as originally filed as the actual cost of the above described improvement is to the estimated cost of the improvement as originally filed.

SECTION 4. That the assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty (30) days after the passage of this Ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in two (2) annual installments. All cash payments shall be made to the Director of Finance of the City. All assessments remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty (30) days shall be certified by the Clerk of Council to the County Fiscal Officer as provided by law, to be placed by him on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxed are collected.

SECTION 5. That the Clerk of this Council shall cause a notice of the passage of this Ordinance to be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in this City, and to continue on file in this office said assessments.

SECTION 6. That the Clerk of this Council is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this Ordinance to the County Fiscal Officer no later than September 9, 2019.

SECTION 7. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 8. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide funds for street lighting installation and maintenance lighting of the aforesaid streets to protect the health, convenience, and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Fairview Park, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR COLLECTION OF THE MONTHLY CHARGE FOR COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE IN THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, OHIO FOR THE TAX YEARS 2020 AND 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of solid waste collection for the tax years 2020 and 2021, in the amount of \$120 per year per residential parcel for each tax year, as reported to the Finance Director and now on file in the office of the Finance Director; be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, and that for the tax years 2020 and 2021, there be and are hereby levied and assessed upon each residential parcel that is subject to collection of solid waste by the City's vendor, the amount reported as aforesaid, which are not in excess of any statutory limitation; and said properties are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement.

SECTION 2. That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid out of the General Fund of the City of Fairview Park, Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this Council hereby finds and determines that the assessments now on file in the office of said Director are in the same proportion to the estimated assessments as originally filed as the actual cost of the above described improvement is to the estimated cost of the improvement as originally filed.

SECTION 4. That the assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty (30) days after the passage of this Ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in two (2) annual installments. All cash payments shall be made to the Director of Finance of the City. All assessments remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty (30) days shall be certified by the Clerk of Council to the County Fiscal Officer as provided by law, to be placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxed are collected.

SECTION 5. That the Clerk of this Council shall cause a notice of the passage of this Ordinance to be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in this City, and to continue on file in this office said assessments.

SECTION 6. That the Clerk of this Council is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this Ordinance to the County Fiscal Officer no later than September 9, 2019.

SECTION 7. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 8. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and for the further reason that it is necessary to provide funds for solid waste collection to protect the health, convenience, and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Fairview Park and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 929.06 OF CHAPTER 929 ENTITLED, "SOLID WASTE COLLECTION CHARGES" OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 929.06 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Fairview Park was amended by Ordinance No. 17-39 to provide that the solid waste collection charges established by Chapter 929 shall expire December 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Fairview Park to extend the charges established by Chapter 929 until December 31, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRVIEW PARK, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Section 929.06 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Fairview Park shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

“ 929.06 EXPIRATION

The charges established under this Chapter shall expire on December 31, 201921.”

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and timely provide for the continuation of the charges under this ordinance, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of a majority plus one of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
